

# Caledonian Pinewood Principles

1. Regenerate and expand Caledonian pinewood naturally.
2. Aim to manage pressures at landscape scale, particularly for larger sites.
3. Where landscape scale management is not yet possible:
  - Aim to manage pressures across the site as a whole.
  - Create and maintain appropriate buffer zones.
  - Plan a transition to landscape scale management in the medium-term.
  - Consider the needs of other ancient woodlands in the surrounding landscape.
4. Ensure management is sufficient to achieve diverse regeneration.
5. Prioritise urgent actions, but plan for long-term management.

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
